ITINERARY

DAY 01 | OCT 09 | MANILA - BARCELONA (D)

Leave Manila on board a prestigious airline bound for Barcelona. Enjoy in-flight amenities and entertainment.

Welcome to Barcelona! the cosmopolitan capital of Spain's is defined by quirky art and architecture, imaginative food and vibrant street life. After airport formalities, proceed to the exit where our representative will meet and assist you. Transfer to your hotel then check-in, dinner & overnight

DAY 02 | OCT 10 | BARCELONA – MONTSERRAT- BARCELONA (B,D)

We make our way to Montserrat to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat (Mass Celebration). See the Royal Basilica and pray to the venerated Black Madonna which according to tradition, was carved by St. Luke. Return to Barcelona and enjoy sightseeing including: Gaudi's La Sagrada Familia, a beautiful, unfinished Roman Catholic basilica of impressive proportions,

panoramic views of the Harbor area, Montjuic, Plaza de España, and Plaza de Catalunya. Spend the afternoon at leisure exploring the colorful Markets of Las Ramblas. Dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

DAY 03 | OCT 11 | BARCELONA – ZARAGOZA – SEGOVIA (B,D)

We will move on to Zaragoza and visit the huge Basilica of the miraculous Nuestra Senora del Pilar. (Mass Celebration) Then on to Segovia for dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 04 | OCT 12 | SEGOVIA – AVILA - FATIMA (B,D)

We are off to the walled town of Avila, made famous by St. Teresa. Visit the Monastery of the Incarnation where St. Teresa spent many years of her life. (Mass Celebration). Continue to Fatima, Portugal where Our Lady of the Rosary appeared to the 3 little shepherds. Upon Arrival check-in at the hotel. Free-time for personal devotion. You can participate in nightly candlelight processions requested by Our Lady. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 05 | OCT 13 | FATIMA (Celebration of the Anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions) (B,D)

Rejoice in Mary's presence and maternal protection! You come here with the same sentiments as those of Blessed Francisco and Jacinta, and the Servant of God Lucia, in order to entrust to Our Lady the intimate confession that the Church, its Priests, clergy, and we all "love", Jesus. In the evening is when we gather for the Main Events! 100 years ago, the Heavenly Queen of Peace, in order to transmit divine help and the promise of sure hope for peace, appeared here. Many faithful have had recourse for Her help and, in their various perils, have looked for Her protection ... and found it. Let us continue to remember the value of the prayer of the Holy Rosary, as well as the message, in order for us to obtain the favors and graces which the Mother of the Redeemer Herself promised the people devoted to her Immaculate Heart. These will be in your hearts, prayers, and memories for the rest of your life.

DAY 06 | OCT 14 | FATIMA - BURGOS (B,D)

Mass Celebration at the Chapel of Apparition. Drive to Burgos the home of "EL CID" and capital of Old Castille in the middle Ages. It was once a seat of the government of the Dictator Franco. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (Mass Celebration)

DAY 07 | OCT 15 | BURGOS – LOYOLA – LOURDES (B,D)

Depart Burgos, heading for Lourdes, France. En route stop in Loyola, the birthplace of St Ignatius of Loyola. Pray at the Basilica. It was in Loyola that Our Lady appeared to St. Ignatius with the Christ Child. Then profound conversion began. Later in life, St. Ignatius renounced his portion of the family's wealth, wrote the famous book of Spiritual Exercises and became the founder of the Jesuit Order. (Mass Celebration) .Then transfer to Lourdes, France. Upon arrival free time to spend your personal devotion to Our Lady. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 08 | OCT 16 | LOURDES (B,D)

Mass Celebration at the Grotto. Rest of the day is free to explore on your own to the Shrines of one of the greatest Marian Pilgrimage sites in Europe. Visit the Grotto, Rosary Basilica, Plus the X, Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, the "Cachot," where Bernadette's impoverished family lived and Parish Church where Bernadette was baptized. Pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous spring or submerge yourself in the healing baths. Experience Christ's love as you walk the life-sized Stations of the Cross. Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. Your role in the universal church will have new meaning as you join the candlelight procession and group rosary.



DAY 09 | OCT 17 | LOURDES-PARIS (TRAIN) (B,D)

After breakfast, board the TGV Train bound for Paris the capital of France. Enjoy guided tour of Paris includes: Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Palace de la Concorde, the Place Vendome, Opera House Notre Dame Cathedral and Sacre Coeur Church. Then continue visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal where we celebrate our Thanks Giving Mass and pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure. After a short free time for shopping, proceed to dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 10 | OCT 18 | PARIS (B,D)

Enjoy full day guided tour with a visit to Eiffel Tower (with 2nd level Eiffel visit) Europe's best known landmark and Paris's most famous symbol, Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Palace de la Concorde, the Place Vendome, Opera House Notre Dame Cathedral, Sacre Coeur Church and Louvre Museum (internal visit). Free-time in the afternoon for shopping at Galeries La Fayette, proceed to dinner in a restaurant.



DAY 11 | OCT 19 | PARIS-NEVERS-PARAY LEMONIAL (B,D)

Drive to Nevers, France. Visit the incorrupt body St. Bernadette Soubirous, miraculously preserved since her death in 1879 at the convent of St. Gildard. Continue to Paray Le Monial for Check-in, dinner and overnight at the hotel. Following to Paray Le Monial to see the place where the Sacred Heart of Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary of Alacoque. The apparitions and subsequent devotion to the Sacred Heart took place in the late 17th century. Visit the Sacre Coeur Basilica (Sacred Heart) (Mass Celebration). As well, the Chapel of la Colombiere where the relics of St. Claude de la Colombiere, confessor of St. Margaret can be found. Dinner and overnight.



DAY 12 | OCT 20 | PARAY LEMONIAL - ARS SUR FORMANS - LYON - LA SALETTE (B,D)

Visit the place of St. John Vianney referred to as the "Curé d'Ars", who is venerated in the Catholic Church as a saint and as the patron saint of parish priests. Catholics attribute this to his saintly life, mortification, his persevering ministry in the sacrament of confession, and his ardent devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Then to Lyon, France to visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fourviere a popular place of pilgrimage, as can be seen from the plaques placed round the wall of the chapel. Afterwards to La Salette for dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 13 | OCT 21 | LA SALETTE - NICE (B,D)

After breakfast, proceed to La Salette where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1846 to two shepherds, Melanie Matthew and Maximin Gird. Our Lady appeared crying, lamenting over the lack of observance of Sundays and the profaning of her Son's holy name. A spring forever marks the spot where the Virgin appeared and where millions of pilgrims come to in order to drink the fresh spring water and to pray. The stunning mountain scenery and lush trails make La Salette one of the most spectacular pilgrimage site in France, with a beautiful Basilica built to honor the Virgin Mary. (Mass Celebration). Continue to Nice, France capital of the Alpes-Maritimes department on the French Riviera. Dinner and overnight stay.



DAY 14 | OCT 22 | NICE – MONACO - FLORENCE (B,D)

We cross the border to Italy and stop at the Principality of Monaco. See the Annunciation Cathedral where Prince Rainier &

Princess Grace are buried. See the Royal Palace and a view of the Monaco Racing Circuit. On to Nice, France for dinner and overnight stay.



DAY 15 | OCT 23 | FLORENCE (B,D)

Guided tour to the historic centre of Florence one of the most beautiful cities in the world and was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1982. Mass Celebration in the Church of Santa Maria Novella. Walking tour will take you to the magnificent Sta. Maria del Fiore Basilica. Highlight visit to see is Michelangelo's monumental figure of David. Continue to the multi-coloured marble Cathedral to see Giotto's bell tower and 'Gates of Paradise' before visiting the Piazza della Signoria with the Palazzo Vecchio, Church of Sta. Croce and Square. Dinner and overnight.



DAY 16 | OCT 24 | FLORENCE-ASSISI-OSIMO-LORETO (B,D)

Visit Assisi the hometown of St. Francis. (Mass Celebration) Commune in the Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humility, forgiveness, simplicity and love for all God's creatures. Hear about monastic life and view priceless frescoes of Giotto adorning the walls of the church. Nearby is the church where the incorrupt body of St. Clare. Then on to Santa Maria Degli Angeli Church to see the thornless rose bush and the Porziuncola. Then onto Osimo the hometown of St. Joseph Cupertino he was an Italian Conventual Franciscan friar who is honored as a Christian mystic and saint. He was said to have been remarkably unclerical, but prone to miraculous levitation and intense ecstatic visions that left him gaping. Visit the Basilica of Saint Joseph of Cupertino and His tomb in the crypt. Later drive to Loreto for dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 17 | OCT 25 | LORETO-LANCIANO -SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO (B,D)

Drive to the Marian Shrine of Loreto see the Holy House of Nazareth and the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. Tradition has it that this is the house in which Mary first prayed the Magnificat, in which Jesus grew to manhood, and in which the Holy Family lived. (Mass Celebration). Then drive to Lanciano, and visit the Church of St. Longinus where we will see the Eucharistic Miracle. On to Padre Pios town of San Giovanni Rotondo. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 18 | OCT 26 | SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO- MONTECASSINO-ROME (B,D)

(Mass Celebration in St. Pio at the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace). Contemplate on the life of the miraculous saint, most beloved of confessors, who received the Stigmata-the five wounds of Jesus Christ. See his cell, museum and former tomb in the original church, and his crypt in the underground Church. Pray in front of the incorrupt body of St. Pio. Drive to Montecassino, the Abbey founded by St. Benedict built on top of a mountain. In another mountain was the abbey where his twin sister St. Scholastica once led young women to the monastic life. Continue to Rome, Italy the capital of Italy and also regarded as one of the world's most beautiful ancient cities.



DAY 19 | OCT 27 | ROME (B,D)

Morning guided tour includes the Vatican to visit St. Peter's Basilica and Square. Enjoy Rome's most famous and iconic monuments - The Roman Coliseum, the magnificent 18th century Trevi Fountain, the monumental stairway of 138 steps in Spanish Steps along with the shops of luxurious branded goods and the Piazza di Spagna. See the Ancient Roman Temple and the Forum of ancient Rome the centre of the city's politics and business at the time. Continue our visit to Rome's Major Basilicas - Santa Maria Maggiore Basilica (Mass Celebration), Basilica of St. John in Lateran, Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Dinner at local Restaurant and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 20 | OCT 28 | ROME - MANILA (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free-time on your own until transfer time to the airport for your flight back to Manila.



DAY 21 | OCT 29 | MANILA

Arrival in Manila from a very memorable tour. Home sweet home.
