DAY 01 | APR 11 | MANILA - PRAGUE

Depart Manila on board your flight to Prague. Enjoy in-flight meals and services.



DAY 02 | APR 12 | PRAGUE (L,D)

Upon arrival in Prague Airport you will find your luggage and exit the baggage claim into the arrivals hall where you will be greeted by your tour escort

DAY 05 | APR 15 | CZESTOCHOWA – AUSCHWITZ – KRAKOW (B,D)

Drive to Auschwitz to visit the **Concentration Camp**, a chilling reminder of the Holocaust. This is also the place where St. Maximilian Kolbe died as prisoner 16770 in Auschwitz. On to Krakow, Poland. Ascend Wawel Hill to visit **Krakow Cathedral** – burial place of Polish heroes and view Wawel Castle, former residence of Polish

kings. In the Old Krakow, visit the medieval Town Square (where today the 12th century Cloth Hall houses an arcade of folk art shops). There's the 14th century **St. Mary's Church**, famous for its baroque altar and life size Marian images). Dinner in a restaurant and overnight the hotel.



DAY 06 | APR 16 | KRAKOW- DIVINE MERCY (LAGIEWNIKI)- KRAKOW (B,D)

In the morning excursion to Lagiewniki, the capital of the Divine Mercy. Through the mediation of St. Faustina, Christ passed on the message of Divine Mercy at Lagiewniki. While here, you will have the opportunity

to visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy that contains images of the Merciful Jesus, relics of St. Faustina, as well as, the Saint's convent chapel and her Tomb. Visit and celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Divinity, which was visited by Saint John Paul II in 2002. Following Mass, have to opportunity to pray by a relic of Saint John Paul II. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 07 | APR 17 | KRAKOW - WADOWICE - BRATISLAVA(B,D)

Morning visit to the Wielicska Salt Mines a unique underground of cave chambers, grotto, chapel and

sculptures all made of salt. It was declared a World Heritage Site by the UNESCO. Pass by Wadowice and realize how Poland with its passionate Catholic faith has contributed a Polish pope and later a saint. Visit his house, now a museum containing mementos of the beloved pope. Also the church where he began his priesthood. Continue to Bratislava. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 08 | APR 18 | BRATISLAVA - BUDAPEST(B,D)

After breakfast, your sightseeing tour today features the Castle Hill, the Fisherman's Bastion to enjoy a panoramic view of the city and the Parliament House,

the 13th century Matthias Coronation Church, the Citadel of Mount Gellert and the Heroes Square. The rest of the day is free to enjoy this twin city at your own pace. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 09 | APR 19 | BUDAPEST - VIENNA(B.D)
