ITINERARY

DAY 01 | DEC 05 | MANILA – AMMAN - PETRA (L,D)

DEPART FOR HOLYLAND

Depart Manila on board prestigious airline bound for Amman. Enjoy- flight amenities and entertainment. Arrived at Amman Airport. After airport formalities, proceed to Madaba land fruits and water where you can see the first Holyland Map. Nearby is **The Shrine of the Beheading of St. John the Baptist where we celebrate our 1st Mass.** Then drive to the hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight.

DAY 02 | DEC 06 | PETRA - AMMAN (B,L,D)

TREASURY & MT.NEBO

Visit the **"Red Rose City"** of Petra. Take a horse ride to the **Siq (Canyon)** half mile unforgettable experience. You will see the **Treasury**, a rose monumental building artfully carved out of sheer rock. Now declared as the **new "7 Wonders of the World.** You will also see the **Roman Theater, The Corinthian Tomb and the Palace Tomb to the Roman Road.** Continue to **Mt. Nebo (Celebrate Mass).** It was in the Bible as the place where Moses was granted a view of the Land that he never enter. God did not allow him to enter the promise land and live out his life together with Joshua and the people he led out of Egypt. This is believed to be the burial site of Moses. Dinner and overnight

DAY 03 | DEC 07 | JORDAN (AMMAN)–ISRAEL (NAZARETH–MT.ARBEL)(B,L,D)

BORDER CROSSING:(AMMAN–NAZARETH–TIBERIAS) & THE ANNUNCIATION

After breakfast inside the hotel and check out. Transfer to **Allenby Bridge for crossing into Israel.** After the inspections, other regulatory procedures and meeting your guide and you'll continue to **Nazareth the city of Jesus' childhood and youth.** (Matthew 2:23). In **Nazareth you will experience the town where Mary once lived and where Jesus lived as a child (Matthew 2:23).** During the visit to Nazareth we visit the **church of the Annunciation which includes the church of St Joseph** which tradition identifies it with the **workshop of Joseph and the house of the Holy family.** We will continue with a visit of the **Church of the Incarnation, viewing at Grotto the remains of the house of the Blessed Virgin where the Angel appeared and announced the good news.** Following Pilgrims path we visit **Mary's well, where often the Virgin Mary would have walked to draw water from the spring.** Make our way back to Tiberias, with a stop at **Mt Arbel,** where you take in a beautiful panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee region where Jesus started His ministry. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 04 | DEC 08 | GALILEE AREA (SEA OF GALILEE – MAGDALA – CAPERNAUM – TABGHA – MOUNT OF BEATITUDES) (B,L,D)

THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST IN THE GALILEE

Today begin this day with a **boat ride on the beautiful and scenic Sea of Galilee (Luke 5:1).** Upon docking the boat, you will have the opportunity to **view the remains of a boat that dates back to the time of Jesus.** Following the Sea of Galilee, drive to **Magdala** this site is the remnants of the city of **Magdala, believed to be the town of Mary Magdalene.** Pilgrims who visit the city will also have the chance to see the best-preserved synagogue from the time of Christ. Continue to **Capernaum, the launching place of Jesus' ministry.** In **Capernaum, see the Synagogue where Jesus taught (Mark 1:21-29) and gave His sermon on the Bread of Life.** On to **Tabgha, where the Miracle of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes took place. (Luke 9:10-17).** Also, in **Tabgha is St. Peter's Primacy where Jesus bestowed church leadership upon Peter (John 21:9).** Then on to the **Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus proclaimed His great Sermon on the Mount (Luke 6:20-49). (Mass Celebration).** Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 05 | DEC 09 | MT. TABOR – CANA – HAIFA (STELLA MARIS) - CAESAREA - BETHLEHEM (B,L,D) THE TRANSFIGURATION

After breakfast, we will drive to the site of the **Transfiguration, Mount Tabor (Matthew 17:1-50).** At this site, you will have some time to reflect on Christ's Humanity and Divinity. Drive on to the village of **Cana, where Jesus performed the Miracle of changing water into wine at the wedding ceremony (Mass Celebration).** Couples will have the opportunity to participate in the ceremony to **renew their wedding vows.** Travel to **Haifa, you will find Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery.** The monastery is located above the **cave where Elijah, the prophet, once lived.** A colorful painting of this "wonder-worker" can be found on the ceiling of the Church. Continue to **Caesarea, which was built by Mt. Herod the Great to catch the sight of the Aqueducts and the Roman Theater.** Shortly after the time of **Jesus Christ, it was revealed to Peter in Caesarea that the Good News (to repent) is not only intended for Jewish people, but also the entire world.** This is the place which officially ended the tradition of adhering to the Jewish ceremonial laws. As a result, Peter baptized a group of gentiles, the Roman Centurion, Cornelius, and his family. Continue North to Haifa. We will transfer to Bethlehem for check-in. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 | DEC 10 | BETHLEHEM - JERICHO - JORDAN RIVER (ORIGINAL BAPTISMAL SITE) - BETHLEHEM (B,L,D) THE NATIVITY, BAPTISM & THE DESERT MONASTERIES

Early morning breakfast then proceed to the **Manger Square which stands in front of the Church of the Nativity.** As you enter the Church, you will proceed down to the **Grotto of the Nativity (Mass Celebration),** which marks the spot of **Our Savior's birth (Matthew 2:1-18).** Beneath the altar, there is a **silver star and a Latin inscription that states: HIC DE VIRGINE MARA JESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary).** In Bethlehem, you will have the opportunity to view the **Shepherd's Fields (Luke 2:8).** In the caves of these fields, you are still able to see the soot marks of fires that shepherds lit to keep warm. Continue to Jericho, the oldest city in the world. At the time of Exodus, Jericho was the point entry of the Israelites (under the leadership of Joshua) into the Promise Land. View Mount of Temptation, where Jesus was led by the Spirit on a 40 days retreat after His baptism and prior to His public ministry. It was also here in Jericho where the diminutive Zacchaeus climbed the sycamore tree to get a glimpse of Jesus. Drive to Jordan River to the original baptismal site where **St. John the Baptist baptized Jesus Christ. (Matthew 3:13-17).** Pilgrims may opt to **renew their baptismal vows.** Dinner and overnight.

DAY 07 | DEC 11 | JERUSALEM: TEMPLE MODEL - MT. OF OLIVES – GETHSEMANE - BETHANY (B,L,D) PALM SUNDAY AND THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN

On to Jerusalem, which houses the **temple to which Jesus was Presented (Luke 2:22).** Visit a model of the **Second Temple as it was in the time of Jesus.** We will make our way to the **Mount of Olives** where you will be able to take in the beautiful, **panoramic view of Jerusalem.** Historically, the **Mount of Olives was a mandatory transit point for Jesus during many iconic moments.** Visit the **Pater Noster Shrine where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer (Pater Noster) (Luke 11:1-4).** You will have the opportunity to stop at **Dominus Flevit (Mass Celebration),** which is a **Church that commemorates where Jesus wept for Jerusalem (Luke 19:41).** Continue on to **Gethsemane, a garden at the foot of the Mount of Olives. Jesus brought His disciples here to pray the night before He was crucified (Luke 22:29-53).** The Garden still contains trees with roots that date back to the time of Jesus. Your next stop, the **Church of All Nations built over the "Rock of Agony". This is where Jesus prayed alone on the night of His arrest.** Throughout this time, you are invited to remain in prayer and to reflect on Christ's agony that He experienced. Head to **Bethany is the site where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead which foreshadows His own Resurrection (John 11:38-44).** Return to hotel for dinner and overnight. Following this visit return to the hotel to enjoy dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 08 | DEC 12 | JERUSALEM (OLD CITY)- HOLY SEPULCHRE – MT. ZION - WESTERN WALL (B,L,D) THE WAY OF THE CROSS, THE CRUCIFIXION,

Early wake-up to begin the **Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross) at the Antonia Fortress.** This is the **spot where Jesus was condemned to death by Pontius Pilate (John 18:28-19:16).** Following His condemnation, He was taken (on the Road to Calvary) to His place of Crucifixion. Reflect upon the Stations of the Cross as you travel through the markets of the **Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher (Luke 23:26-33).** This sacred destination is the site of **Calvary (Jesus' crucifixion place) and His tomb (Luke 23: 50-55).** Celebrate **Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.** We will continue our day with a visit to the **Church of St. Anne's, the home of Jesus' maternal grandparents**

(Anne and Joachim); and the **Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the crippled man (John 5:1-9).** You will have the opportunity to visit the **Western Wall, which is the last remnant of the Jewish Temple after it was destroyed in 70 A.D.** Continue with a visit to the **house of the High Priest Caiaphas (Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu).** This Church commemorates where **Jesus was examined and eventually imprisoned before the Council in Jerusalem. It also commemorates Peter's Denial of Christ (John 18:15-18),** Peter's repentance, and Jesus' forgiveness of Peter. You will also visit the **Upper Room on Mt. Zion. The Upper Room is where Jesus and His disciples celebrated the Last Supper (Matthew 26:17-30) and where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His Death and Resurrection (Mark 16:14).** In addition, visit the nearby Benedictine Church of the **Dormition. Tradition tells us that this Church is where Mary, the Mother of Jesus, "fell asleep." At the end of this prayerful day, return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.**

DAY 09 | DEC 13 | JERUSALEM - EIN KAREM - EMMAUS-QUMRAM - DEAD SEA (B,L,D) EARLY YEARS IN JERUSALEM, BAPTISM & RESURRECTION

Drive to the **village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of John the Baptist.** It is known that there are two churches in **Ein Karem, both representing the two homes of Zechariah and Elizabeth.** The first is in a valley where the birth of St. John the Baptist is commemorated (Luke 1:39-80) in the **Church of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist.** The second is on a hill where Elizabeth spent five months in seclusion (Luke 1:24) at the **Church of the Visitation.** You will have a chance to visit both of these churches and have the opportunity to pray the **Mystery of the Rosary** as you walk up the hill to the Church of the Visitation. Continue visit to **Abou Ghosh, probably the site of Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to the two Disciples after the Resurrection.** Here, visit the lovely Crusader church and meditate in the beautiful gardens tended by the nuns. Drive through the Valley of Elah, mentioned in the Old Testament as where the events of **Samson & Delilah and David & Goliath took place.** Also, here is the Monastery of Beit Jimal, which dates to the 5th century and is where **St Stephen is buried.** Travel down to **Qumran.** Qumran is made up of 2,000-year-old Ruins from the days of the **Second Temple and also the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were written and discovered (Ezekiel 47:8-10).** These writings have helped further the understanding of **Jewish background in Christianity.** Then onto the **Dead sea, the lowest point of the earth.** Experience floating on its mineral rich water. Dinner & overnight at the hotel in Deadsea.

DAY 10 | DEC 14 | ISRAEL - EGYPT (B,L,D)

BORDER CROSSING: (DEADSEA– TABA BORDER – ST. CATHERINE)

Breakfast at hotel. Check out then drive to **Eilat** the winter resort of Israel. Continue to **Taba Border** and cross into Egypt. You will be met and assisted then drive to **St Catherine** for dinner & overnight at the hotel.

DAY 11 | DEC 15 | ST. CATHERINE – MOUNT SINAI – CAIRO (B,L,D)

MT. SINAI & TEN COMMANDMENTS

Early morning mountain climbing on Mount Sinai, where the Ten Commandments were given to Moses (Optional). Enjoy the breathtaking view of sunrise from the peak. Return to your hotel for breakfast. Check out then visit **St Catherine Monastery (if open).** Leave for Cairo, the capital of Egypt. Check in at the hotel in CAIRO for dinner and overnight.

DAY 12 | DEC 16 | CAIRO (B,L,D)

HIGHLIGHTS OF CAIRO

Mass celebration in a Catholic Church. Marvel at the **Pyramids of Giza and the nearby Sphinx.** See a **Papyrus factory, cotton shop and essence shop.** Continue visit to the **Egyptian Museum of Antiquities,** where you can see the finest displays of Artifacts, Relics, Statues and Jewels from all of the Pharaohs Reigns. On to Old Cairo - the **Hanging Church** built in the 4th BC. This Basilica was built on the top of the south gate of the Fortress of Babylon. Then visit **Church of Abu Sergah, built on the cave in which the Holy Family stayed when they escaped from King Herod.** Enjoy a Nile Cruise dinner with cultural and belly dancing show. Return to your hotel for overnight.

DAY 13 | DEC 17 | CAIRO - MANILA (B,L)

HOLY FAMILY & DEPARTURE

See the **Church in Zeitoun** where our Lady appeared. Enroute to the airport, pass by the **Saint Mary's Church in Maadi.** This is believed that the Holy Family passed by the exact same location of the church, and from there started their journey to Upper Egypt. Celebrate our **Thanks Giving Mass.** Then transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

DAY 14 | DEC 18 | MANILA

Arrival in Manila. Home sweet home.
