

#### DAY 12 | FEB 19 | BARCELONA- AVIGNON (B, D)

A spring forever marks the spot where the Virgin appeared and where millions of pilgrims come to in order to drink the fresh spring water and to pray. The stunning mountain scenery and lush trails make La Salette one of the most spectacular pilgrimage site in France, with a beautiful Basilica built to honor the Virgin Mary. (Mass Celebration). Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



#### DAY 14 | FEB 21 | LA SALETTE - TURIN (B. D)

After breakfast. Drive to Turin, Italy. Visit the **Doumo San Giovanni** where the **Holy Shroudof Turin is enshrined**. It is a **centuries old linen cloth that bears the image believe to be Jesus of Nazareth**. (**Mass at the Doumo San Giovanni**). Dinner and overnight.



#### DAY 15 | FEB 22 | TURIN - FLORENCE (B, D)

Drive to Florence capital of Italy's Tuscany region and home to many masterpieces of Renaissance art and architecture. Guided tour to the historic centre of Florence one of the most beautiful cities in the world and was declared a World Heritage Site by

Head to the hilltop town. During his stay in Orvieto, St. Thomas completed his Summa contra Gentiles in this place. Orientation tour shows you the **Duomo di Orvieto**, a large 14th century Roman Catholic Cathedral. A miracle said to have occurred when a traveling priest who had doubts about the truth of transubstantiation found that his Host was bleeding so much that it stained the altar cloth. The building was then constructed to commemorate the miracle and house the **Corporal of Bolsena**. The cloth is now stored in the Chapel of the Corporal inside the cathedral. Continue to **Assisi the** 

hometown of St. Francis. (Mass Celebration) Commune in the Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humility, forgiveness, simplicity and love for all God's creatures. Hear about monastic life and view priceless frescoes of Giotto adorning the walls of the church. Nearby is the church where the incorrupt body of St. Clare. Then on to Santa Maria Degli Angeli Church to see the thornless rose bush and the Porziunco-la. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



#### DAY 17 | FEB 24 | ASSISI - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO (B.D.)

After breakfast. Drive to Padre Pio's town of San Giovanni Rotondo.. (Mass Celebration in St. Pio at the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace). Contemplate on the life of the miraculous saint, most beloved of confessors, who received the Stigmata-the five wounds of Jesus Christ. See his cell, museum and former tomb in the original church,

and his crypt in the underground Church. Pray in front of the incorrupt body of St. Pio.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel



## DAY 18 | FEB 25 | SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO— MONTECASSINO-ROME (B,D)

Drive to Montecassino, the Abbey founded by St. benedict in the year 529 and built on top of a mountain. The Benedictine rule of "Ora et Labora" meaning "Pray and Work" follows eight hours of prayer, eight hours of sleep and eight hours of manual work of spiritual reading or charity. It is written that one notorious monk disagreed with this rule and tried to poison St. Benedict. When St.

Benedict made the sign of the cross, the chalice that contained the poison broke and the plot was discovered. In another mountain was the abbey where his twin sister St. Scholastica once led young women to the monastic life. Continue to Rome, Italy the capital of Italy and also regarded as one of the world's most beautiful ancient cities. Visit an **Outlet shop in Rome**. The proceed to dinner in a restaurant and overnight at the hotel.



#### DAY 19 | FEB 26 | ROME (B.D)

Morning guided tour includes the Vatican to visit St. Peter's Basilica and Square. Visit the Vatican Museum. Continue visit to Rome's Major Basilicas - Santa Maria Maggiore Basilica (Mass Celebration), Basilica of St. John in Lateran, Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls.
