ITINERARY

[DAY 01 | MAY 01 - 02 | MANILA – AMMAN - PETRA \(L,D\)](#)

DEPART FOR HOLYLAND

Depart Manila on board prestigious airline bound for Amman. Enjoy- flight amenities and entertainment. Arrived at Amman Airport. After airport formalities, proceed to Madaba land fruits and water where you can see the first Holyland Map. Nearby is **The Shrine of the Beheading of St. John the Baptist** where we celebrate our 1st Mass. Then drive to the hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight.

[DAY 02 | MAY 03 | PETRA - AMMAN \(B,L,D\)](#)

TREASURY & MT.NEBO

Visit the "Red Rose City" of Petra. Take a horse ride to the Siq (Canyon) half mile unforgettable experience. You will see the **Treasury**, a rose monumental building artfully carved out of sheer rock. Now declared as the new "7 Wonders of the World. You will also see the **Roman Theater, The Corinthian Tomb and the Palace Tomb to the Roman Road**. Continue to **Mt. Nebo (Celebrate Mass)**. It was in the Bible as the place where Moses was granted a view of the Land that he never enter. God did not allow him to enter the promise land and live out his life together with Joshua and the people he led out of Egypt. This is believed to be the burial site of Moses. Dinner and overnight

[DAY 03 | MAY 04 | AMMAN – NAZARETH \(B,L,D\)](#)

BORDER CROSSING:(JORDAN - ISRAEL) & THE ANNUNCIATION

After breakfast. Transfer to **Allenby Bridge** for crossing into Israel. After the inspections, other regulatory procedures and meeting your guide and you'll continue to Drive to **Nazareth the city of Jesus' childhood and youth**. (Matthew 2:23). In **Nazareth you will experience the town where Mary once lived and where Jesus lived as a child (Matthew 2:23)**. During the visit to Nazareth we visit the **church of the Annunciation** which includes the **church of St Joseph** which tradition identifies it with the **workshop of Joseph and the house of the Holy family**. We will continue with a visit of the **Church of the Incarnation, viewing at Grotto the remains of the house of the Blessed Virgin where the Angel appeared and announced the good news**. Following Pilgrims path we visit **Mary's well, where often the Virgin Mary would have walked to draw water from the spring**. Check-in, dinner and overnight stay in Nazareth.

[DAY 04 | MAY 05 | CANA - SEA OF GALILEE – MAGDALA – JORDAN RIVER - TIBERIAS](#)

WEDDING IN CANA & BAPTISM

Head to the village of **Cana, where Jesus performed the Miracle of changing water into wine at the wedding ceremony (Mass Celebration)**. Couples will have the opportunity to participate in the ceremony to renew their wedding vows. Make our way back to Tiberias, with a stop at **Mt. of Precipice**, where you can take a paved lane to the magnificent observation point on top of the mountain. The sheer sloped mountain, 397 meters high, provides one of the best, most beautiful observation points over Israel Valley and its surrounding mountains: The Carmel Mountains, The Gilled Mountains and the Tabor Mountain. Continue to Tiberias and experience **boat ride on the beautiful and scenic Sea of Galilee (Luke 5:1)**. Upon docking the boat, you will have the opportunity to **view the remains of a boat that dates back to the time of Jesus**. Following the Sea of Galilee, drive to Magdala this site is the remnants of the city of **Magdala, believed to be the town of Mary Magdalene**. Pilgrims who visit the city will also have the chance to see the best-preserved synagogue from the time of Christ. Travel to Jordan River to the baptismal site where **St. John the Baptist baptized Jesus Christ. (Matthew 3:13-17)**. Pilgrims will have the opportunity to renew the baptismal vows. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

[DAY 05 | MAY 06 | MOUNT TABOR– CAPERNAUM – TABGHA – MOUNT OF BEATITUDES \(B,L,D\)](#)

THE TRANSFIGURATION & THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST IN THE GALILEE

We will drive to the site of the **Transfiguration, Mount Tabor (Matthew 17:1-50)**. At this site, you will have some time to reflect on Christ's Humanity and Divinity. Continue to Capernaum, the **launching place of Jesus' ministry**. In Capernaum, see the **Synagogue where Jesus taught (Mark 1:21-29) and gave His sermon on the Bread of Life**. On to Tabgha, where the **Miracle of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes took place. (Luke 9:10-17)**. Also, in Tabgha is **St. Peter's Primacy where Jesus bestowed church leadership upon Peter (John 21:9)**. Then on to the **Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus proclaimed His great Sermon on the Mount (Luke 6:20-49) (Mass Celebration)**. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

[DAY 06 | MAY 07 | BETANY - JERICHO – QUMRAM -DEAD SEA \(B,L,D\)](#)

OLDEST CITY & DEADSEA

Head to **Bethany is the site where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead which foreshadows His own Resurrection (John 11:38-44)**. Continue drive to Jericho , the oldest city in the world. At the time of Exodus, Jericho was the point entry of the Israelites (under the leadership of Joshua) into the Promise Land. See the **Mount of Temptation**, where Jesus was led by the Spirit on a 40 days retreat after His baptism and prior to His public ministry. It was also here in Jericho where the diminutive Zaccchaeus climbed the sycamore tree to get a glimpse of Jesus. Travel down to **Qumran**. Qumran is made up of 2,000-year-old Ruins from the days of the Second Temple and also the site where the **Dead Sea Scrolls were written and discovered (Ezekial 47:8-10)**. These writings have helped further the understanding of Jewish background in Christianity. Then onto the **Dead sea, the lowest point of the earth**. Experience floating on its mineral rich water. Dinner & overnight at Deadsea hotel.

[DAY 07 | MAY 08 | EIN KAREM - BETHLEHEM\(B,L,D\)](#)

VISITATION & BIRTH PLACE

Travel to **Ein Karem, the birthplace of John the Baptist**. It is known that there are two churches in **Ein Karem, both representing the two homes of Zechariah and Elizabeth**. The first is in a valley where the birth of St. John the Baptist is commemorated (Luke 1:39-80) in the **Church of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist**. The second is on a hill where Elizabeth spent five months in seclusion (Luke 1:24) at the **Church of the Visitation**. You will have a chance to visit both of these churches and have the opportunity to pray the **Mystery of the Rosary** as you walk up the hill to the Church of the Visitation. Journey to the town of Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus Christ. Proceed to the **Manger Square which stands in front of the Church of the Nativity**. As you enter the Church, you will proceed down to the **Grotto of the Nativity (Mass Celebration) which marks the spot of Our Savior's birth (Matthew 2:1- 18)**. Beneath the altar, there is a **silver star and a Latin inscription that states: HIC DE VIRGINE MARA JESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary)**.. In Bethlehem, you will also visit the **Shepherd's Fields and see caves** where shepherds "kept watch over their flock" still abound in the area east of Bethlehem. Here, the Gospel of Luke (Luke 2:8) tells us, an angel announced the birth of Jesus. Dinner & overnight at the hotel

[DAY 08 | MAY 09 | MT. OF OLIVES – GETHSEMANE – WESTERN WALL - JERUSALEM: TEMPLE MODEL \(B,L,D\) PALM SUNDAY AND THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN](#)

We will make our way to the **Mount of Olives** where you will be able to take in the beautiful, **panoramic view of Old City of Jerusalem**. Historically, the **Mount of Olives was a mandatory transit point for Jesus during many iconic moments**. Visit the **Pater Noster Shrine** where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer (**Pater Noster**) (Luke 11:1-4). Then walk down to the Palm Sunday Road to arrive at the **Church of Dominus Flevit (Mass Celebration)** which is a church that commemorates where Jesus wept for Jerusalem (Luke 19:41). Continue on to **Gethsemane**, a garden at the foot of the Mount of Olives. **Jesus brought His disciples here to pray the night before He was crucified (Luke 22:29-53)**. The Garden still contains trees with roots that date back to the time of Jesus. Your next stop, the **Church of All Nations built over the "Rock of Agony"**. This is where Jesus prayed alone on the night of His arrest. Throughout this time, you are invited to remain in prayer and to reflect on Christ's agony that He experienced. Continue visit to **Western Wall or "Wailing Wall"**, is the most religious site in the world for the Jewish people. We will also visit **Israel Museum**, where we'll see the **shrine of the book**- where the Dead Sea scrolls are kept and the **model city of Jerusalem** from the second temple era. See a model of the **Second Temple as it was in the time of Jesus**. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

[DAY 09 | MAY 10 |JERUSALEM \(OLD CITY\)- HOLY SEPULCHRE – MT. ZION - EMMAUS \(B,L,D\)](#)

THE WAY OF THE CROSS & THE CRUCIFIXION

Early morning to enter the Old City of Jerusalem at the Antonia Fortress. Visit the visit to the **Church of St. Anne's, the home of Jesus' maternal grandparents (Anne and Joachim); and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the crippled man (John 5:1-9)**. Proceed to **Church of Ecce Homo** where we shall celebrate mass. Then we begin the **Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross)**. This is the spot where Jesus was condemned to death by **Pontius Pilate (John 18:28-19:16)**. Following His condemnation, He was taken (on the Road to Calvary) to His place of Crucifixion. Reflect upon the Stations of the Cross as you travel through the markets of the **Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher (Luke 23:26-33)**. This sacred destination is the site of Calvary (Jesus' crucifixion place) and His tomb (Luke 23: 50-55). You will also visit the **Upper Room on Mt. Zion**. The Upper Room is where Jesus and His disciples celebrated the Last Supper (Matthew 26:17-30) and where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His Death and Resurrection (Mark 16:14). Nearby is the **tomb of King David**. Nearby is **Benedictine Church of the Dormition**. Tradition tells us that this Church is where **Mary, the Mother of Jesus, "fell asleep."** At the end of this prayerful day, Continue to the **house of the High Priest Caiaphas (Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu)**. This Church commemorates where Jesus was examined and eventually imprisoned before the Council in Jerusalem. It also commemorates **Peter's Denial of Christ (John 18:15-18)**, Peter's repentance, and Jesus' forgiveness of Peter. Drive to **Abou Ghosh, probably the site of Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to the two Disciples after the Resurrection**. Here, visit the lovely Crusader church and meditate in the beautiful gardens tended by the nuns. Continue visit to **Abou Ghosh, probably the site of Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to the two Disciples after the Resurrection**. Here, visit the lovely Crusader church and meditate in the beautiful gardens tended by the nuns. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

[DAY 10 | MAY 11 | ISRAEL- EGYPT\(B,L,D\)](#)

BORDER CROSSING: (DEADSEA– TABA BORDER – ST. CATHERINE)

Breakfast at hotel. Check out then drive to **Eilat** the winter resort of Israel. Continue to **Taba Border** and cross into Egypt. You will be met and assisted then drive to **St Catherine** for dinner & overnight at the hotel.

[DAY 11 | MAY 12 | ST. CATHERINE – MOUNT SINAI – CAIRO \(B,L,D\)](#)

MT. SINAI & TEN COMMANDMENTS

Early morning mountain climbing on **Mount Sinai**, where the Ten Commandments were given to Moses (Optional). Enjoy the breathtaking view of sunrise from the peak. Return to your hotel for breakfast. Check out then visit **St Catherine Monastery (if open)**. Leave for Cairo, the capital of Egypt. Check in at the hotel in CAIRO for dinner and overnight.

[DAY 12 | MAY 13 | CAIRO \(B,L,D\)](#)

HIGHLIGHTS OF CAIRO

Mass celebration in a Catholic Church. Marvel at the **Pyramids of Giza and the nearby Sphinx**. See a Papyrus factory, cotton shop and essence shop. Continue visit to the **Egyptian Museum of Antiquities**, where you can see the finest displays of Artifacts, Relics, Statues and Jewels from all of the Pharaohs Reigns. to Old Cairo – the **Hanging Church** built in the 4th. This Basilica was built on the top of the south gate of the Fortress of Babylon. Then Visit **Church of Abu Sergah**, built on the cave in which the Holy Family stayed when they escaped from King Herod. Enjoy a Nile Cruise dinner with cultural and belly dancing show. Return to your hotel for overnight.

[DAY 13 | MAY 14 - 15| CAIRO - MANILA \(B,L\)](#)

DEPART FOR MANILA

After breakfast, See the **Church in Zeitoun** where our Lady appeared. According to tradition, the site is one of the locations where the Holy family stayed during their flight into Egypt. Then transfer to the airport for your departure flight. Arrival in Manila. Home sweet home.
